STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Officers of the Senate and House.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. Section thirteen of chapter one hundred of the
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 "six" in the first line of the second paragraph of said section
4 and inserting in place thereof the word 'nine' so that said
5 paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

'The assistant secretary of the senate shall receive a salary 2 of nine hundred dollars; his work shall be performed under 3 the direction of the secretary.'

Sect. 2. Section fourteen of chapter one hundred of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word

3 "six" in the first line of the second paragraph of said section 4 and inserting in place thereof the word 'nine,' so that said 5 paragraph, as amended shall read as follows:

'The assistant clerk of the house shall receive a salary of 2 nine hundred dollars; his work shall be performed under the 3 direction of the clerk.'

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
