STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to Catching Smelts in Salt Pond in the
Town of Bluehill.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of the private and special laws of chapter two
2 hundred eight of the year eighteen hundred eighty is here-
3 by amended by adding at the end of such section the fol-
4 lowing: 'except that fish traps constructed of brush and
5 twine supported by stakes, driven into the bed of said pond,
6 may also be employed for the catching of smelts,' so that
7 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'All persons are forbidden to take any smelts in the Salt
2 pond in the towns of Bluehill, Sedgwick and Brooklin, Han-

3 cock county, in any other manner than by hook and line,
4 except that fish traps constructed of brush and twine, sup-
5 ported by stakes, driven into the bed of said pond, may also
6 be employed for the catching of smelts.'
