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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Danforth for Support  
of Isaac Paul and Family, Indians.

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Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to  
2 be paid to the town of Danforth, the sum of thirty-four  
3 dollars, to reimburse said town for money expended for  
4 support of Isaac Paul and family, Indians.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is for medical attendance for Isaac Paul and  
family, New Brunswick Indians, in 1925. The claim was not  
allowed in the usual manner for the reason that the Selectmen  
of Danforth did not procure an affidavit from Mr. Paul. The  
family left town before they had opportunity to do this, and  
their whereabouts have been unknown since that time.
