RESOLVE, in Favor of W. S. Poland of Belfast, for Reimbursement for Amount Paid the State for Dog Tax, for Which No Refund Was Made.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid to W. S. Poland, to reimburse him for amount paid 3 the state for dog tax, for which no refund was made by it 4 to the town of Searsmont, the sum of sixty-four dollars and 5 eighty-nine cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The treasurer of Searsmont, by error, did not send to the state treasurer, the dog tax until too late to be reimbursed. The town must lose same unless the state reimburses for same.
