STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Lincoln Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph four of section nineteen of chapter two hundred thirty-nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred three thirteen is hereby amended by striking out in the third line thereof the word "two" and inserting in place thereof the word 'four,' so that said paragraph shall read as follows:

'Said salary shall not be paid until said judge shall have paid into the county treasury all fees so received by him. Said recorder shall receive a salary of four hundred dollars per year.'
