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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

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RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Vanceboro for Support  
of Otis L. Crocker, a State Pauper.

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Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to  
2 be paid to the town of Vanceboro, the sum of seven hundred  
3 and thirty-one dollars and sixty-four cents, to reimburse  
4 said town for money expended for support of Otis L. Crocker,  
5 er, a state pauper.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Otis L. Crocker has been cared for as a pauper in the town of Vanceboro since the latter part of the year 1924, and the town officials have made every possible effort to fix the liability for his support, but cannot find any evidence that he belongs in any town. He lived at Reed Plantation for a number of years prior to 1924, and had some assistance every year or nearly every year while there. He is old and infirm, and has no relatives who can help him.

The state has passed a resolve for reimbursement of town of Vanceboro for such support for a period prior to this claim.
