# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Richmond for Support of Arthur H. Weeks and Family, State Paupers.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to the town of Richmond, the sum of fifty-eight 3 dollars, to reimburse said town for money expended for 4 support of Arthur H. Weeks and family, state paupers, in 5 the year nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve covers the expense of setting a broken arm for the child of Arthur H. Weeks, also medical attendance and expenses of committing said Arthur H. Weeks to the Augusta State Hospital. This family has no settlement in the town of Richmond, and that town is unable to prove settlement in any other town.
