RESOLVE, Reimbursing Town of Machiasport for Medical
Expenses of Indians.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of thirty-four dollars and forty-five cents (\$34.45) to
3 reimburse the town of Machiasport for medical expenses of
4 Indians.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Machiasport expended the above amount for doctor's bills and medicine furnished Joe Moore and John Socktomah, members of the Pasasmaquoddy tribe of Indians, in the years 1924, 1925 and 1926.
