RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Lebanon for Support

of Mary Mawson and Child, State Paupers.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be 2 paid the town of Lebanon the sum of ninety-five dollars, to 3 reimburse said town for money expended for support of 4 Mary Mawson and child, state paupers.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mary Mawson and child had help from the Town of Lebanon to the amount of ninety-five dollars as shown by this resolve. The overseers of the poor of Lebanon made claim against the state at the time, but the evidence filed was not sufficient to show the liability of the state and before they could get any further information the woman and child had left the state and their whereabouts have not since been known to the overseers of the poor of Lebanon.
