STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal
Court of Brunswick.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section eleven of chapter two hundred seventy-
2 seven of the private and special laws of the state of Maine
3 which amended chapter one hundred ninety-five of the pub-
4 lic laws of eighteen hundred fifty as amended by chapter
5 five hundred sixty-five of the private and special laws of
6 eighteen hundred seventy-four, is hereby amended by strik-
7 ing from the second line thereof the words "six hundred"
8 and substituting therefor the words 'one thousand,' so that
9 said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 11. The judge of said court shall receive an annual
2 salary of one thousand dollars in full for all services, pay-

3 able quarterly on the last days of March, June, September
4 and December from the treasury of Cumberland county.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 1927.
