STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Make the Chairman of the Androscoggin County
Commissioners a Full Time Office with the Duty of Superintendence of Buildings and to Increase His Salary to Fifteen
Hundred Dollars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-two of chapter one hundred seventeen of the
revised statutes of Maine is hereby amended by inserting
after the word "dollars" in the fifth line thereof, the words
'except the chairman of said Commission who shall devote
each full working day to his duties, which shall be hereby
increased by adding to them the superintendence of the
county buildings and for all his services his salary shall be
the sum of fifteen hundred dollars per annum, so that the

9 amended section shall read beginning at the fifth line there-10 of:

'Androscoggin, seven hundred fifty dollars, except the 2 chairman of said commission who shall devote each full 3 working day to his duties, which shall be hereby increased 4 by adding to them the superintendence of the county build-5 ings and for all his services his salary shall be the sum of 6 fifteen hundred dollars per annum.'
