STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of George E. Sparrow, of Pittston, for Reimbursement for Damage Done His Fowl by Foxes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid to George E. Sparrow of Pittston, to reimburse him 3 for damage done his fowl by foxes, the sum of thirty-four 4 dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Sparrow had twenty hens and seventy chickens killed by foxes in the summer and fall of nineteen hundred twenty-five.
