AN ACT Relative to Clerk Hire in the Office of the Clerk of Courts, Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The clerk of the judicial courts in the county of Penob-2 scot, by and with the approval of any justice of the su-

3 preme judicial court, may employ, from time to time, such

4 clerks or typists as may be necessary to efficiently carry

5 on the work of his office. The compensation of said clerks

6 or typists to be fixed by said clerk of courts, with the ap-

7 proval of said justice, and paid from the county treasurer.
