AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-five of Chapter Two Hundred and Nineteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to Clerk Hire in the Registry of Deeds for Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1921, c. 219, Sec. 45; 1925, c. 41; relating to clerk
2 in county offices, amended. That portion of section forty-
3 five of chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public
4 laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, as amended by
5 chapter forty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred
6 and twenty-five, relating to clerk hire in the county offices
7 in Oxford county, is hereby further amended by striking
8 out the words "six hundred twenty-four" in the third line
9 of the subparagraph relating to Oxford county and insert-

10 ing in the place thereof the words 'eight hundred,' so that
11 said subparagraph of said section, as amended, shall read
12 as follows:

'Clerk hire in the office of the register of deeds, increased.
2 Oxford county. For clerks in the office of the register
3 of deeds, eight hundred dollars, and such additional amount
4 as may be authorized by the county commissioners; for
5 clerks in the office of the register of probate, five hundred
6 and twenty dollars; for clerks in the office of clerk of court,
7 six hundred dollars.'
