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House Amendment "A" to House Paper 1216, House Document 473, "An Act to Amend Section One Hundred Forty-two, Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes Relating to Diplomas to be Issued by State Normal Schools.

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Amend by striking out all after the enacting clause and  
2 inserting in place thereof the following:

'Section one hundred forty-two, chapter sixteen of the  
2 revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding at the end  
3 of the paragraph, "provided, further, that the state board  
4 of trustees for normal schools may confer appropriate edu-  
5 cational degrees based upon four years of academic and  
6 professional instruction with such equipment and faculties  
7 as will safeguard the integrity and standardization of the

8 degrees conferred," so that said section, when amended, shall  
9 read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Any student who completes the course of study  
2 prescribed, and otherwise complies with the regulations of  
3 the school, shall receive a diploma certifying the same, pro-  
4 vided, further, that the state board of trustees for normal  
5 schools may confer appropriate educational degrees based  
6 upon four years of academic and professional instruction  
7 with such equipment and faculties as will safeguard the  
8 integrity of the degrees conferred.'
