IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

House Amendment "A" to House Paper 888, House Document 465, "An Act Relating to the Fees of Sheriffs and Their Deputies."

Amend by striking out all after the enacting clause and 2 inserting in place thereof the following:

'Section five of chapter one hundred and eighteen of the 2 revised statutes, relating to fees of sheriffs and their depu-3 ties as amended by chapter eighty-five of public laws of 4 nineteen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby further amended 5 by adding thereto the following paragraph: For serving 6 bills in equity or the subpoena issued thereon, divorce libels, 7 notices of foreclosure of mortgages of real estate, subpoena 8 and application for debtor to disclose before a commissioner,

9 or copies of writs of entry served upon tenants in possession 10 of demanded premises when defendant is not in possession, 11 the sheriff or his deputy shall receive the sum of one dollar 12 and twenty-five cents when such service is made in hand, 13 and seventy-five cents when service is made by leaving copy 14 of such of the above as are not required by law to be served 15 in hand at the last and usual place of abode, in addition to 16 his travel, and for the copy, when required to be attested by 17 him, at the rate hereinbefore provided, and in all cases, the 18 officer making service shall make a return of his service on 19 the bill or subpoena, libel, notice of foreclosure, citation or 20 other precept, without charge or fee for so doing.

For any of the above enumerated services which a con-2 stable may legally perform, he shall receive the same fee 3 as is provided for deputy sheriffs.

All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.'
