RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Surry.

Resolved: Any unexpended balance of the sum appropri-2 ated by the legislature of nineteen hundred twenty-five, for 3 the rebuilding of Young's bridge in Surry, be and hereby 4 is, transferred to and appropriated to the reconstruction of 5 the "Kane bridge," so called, in the town of Surry, the same 6 to apply to the apportionment under the "bridge act," so 7 called, to the town of Surry in such reconstruction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The bridge is on the main highway between Ellsworth and western Hancock county. It has been authorized by the joint board of the state highway commission, the county commission and municipal officers. This balance is to apply pro tanto to the amount Surry is required to contribute towards the bridge.
