STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to State Aid Apportioned to Cities and
Towns for the Improvement of Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All moneys previously apportioned by the state
2 to cities and towns as "state aid" for the improvement of
3 highways, now in the state treasury and which has re-
4 mained therein unexpended for three years or more shall
5 be added to the next regular appropriation to be apportioned
6 to the cities and towns by the state highway commission.

Sect. 2. All moneys hereafter apportioned by the state to
2 the cities and towns for the improvement of highways, which
3 shall remain in the state treasury unexpended for a period

4 of three years, may at the option of the state highway com-
5 mission, be added to the regular biennial appropriation for
6 state aid to be by said commission apportioned to said cities
7 and towns.
