STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Town of Gorham.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

For the purpose of completing a continuous highway from

- 2 the town of Alfred, in the county of York, to the Ossipee
- 3 Trail, so called, in Gorham, in the county of Cumberland,
- 4 said town of Gorham is authorized to unite with the towns
- 5 of Alfred, Waterboro, Hollis, and Buxton under the pro-
- 6 visions of chapter one hundred fifty-four of the public laws
- 7 of nineteen hundred seventeen, and to raise and appropriate
- 8 money as therein provided.

Said union, so constituted, shall be entitled to receive from

- 2 the state, the apportionment as provided in said chapter and
- 3 be subject of all the provisions thereof.

Any funds not used in the construction of the road lead-

- 2 ing from Gorham to Standish, in the towns of Gorham,
- 3 Standish and Sebago, now in process of construction under
- 4 said act, shall be transferred to be used upon said continu-
- 5 ous highway leading from Alfred to the Ossipee Trail.
