STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Fees of Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eight of chapter one hundred and eighteen of the
2 revised statutes, as amended by chapter thirty-six of the
3 public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby fur-
4 ther amended by striking out in the fourth line thereof the
5 word "four" and inserting in place thereof the word 'five,'
6 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Grand and traverse jurors, attending the supreme judicial
2 court or superior courts, and jurors attending on any other
3 occasion prescribed by law, shall each be allowed five dol-
4 lars a day for their attendance, and six cents a mile for
5 their travel out and home, to be paid out of the county
6 treasury.'
