STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Sherman to Assist in
Support of Pauper.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen
3 hundred twenty-seven and two hundred fifty dollars for the
4 year nineteen hundred twenty-eight to aid the town of Sher-
5 man in support of John Nicholson.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This man is so drawn up by what is said to be rheumatism that his knees press against his chest, knee joints stiff and legs drawn up. He is unable to wait on himself and requires attention much of the time. He is about 54 years old, born in Nova Scotia. The town of Sherman pays \$25.00 per week to have him taken care of in Millinocket. Unable to find any one in Sherman who would take care of him for this price, also unable to find any one in any other nearby town who would consider a lower price.

Sherman is in debt, has a .062 tax rate, and has other expensive paupers in addition to this one.
