Senate Document 259 as amended by House Amendment 2 A is hereby further amended by inserting therein after sec-3 tion sixteen as section seventeen the following:

'Sect. 17. If and when, with the consent of Congress, any 2 agreement or compact shall be entered into by and between 3 the state of Maine and another state or states relative to 4 any of the subjects covered by this act, thereupon any and 5 all provisions of this act shall be subject to the terms of 6 said agreement or compact, and any and all contracts and 7 permits for the sale of surplus power, as provided for in 8 this act, shall be governed by and subject to the terms of 9 said agreement or compact in like manner and with the same
