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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN**

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**AN ACT to Provide for Compensation for Justices of the  
Superior Courts.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The justices of the superior courts shall each  
2 receive an annual salary of six thousand dollars, together  
3 with actual expenses as now provided by law.

Sect. 2. Chapter one hundred seventeen, section six of  
2 the revised statutes, chapter two hundred sixty, section nine  
3 of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, chapter  
4 nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, and  
5 chapter one hundred ninety-two, section one of the public

6 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, are each amended in  
7 accordance with this chapter.

Sect. 3. The provisions of this act shall relate back to  
2 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, so that  
13 the increase herein provided shall take effect as of that date.
