STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Caribou, for Reimbursement of Moneys Expended in Defending Five Actions at Law.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid the town of Caribou, to reimburse for expenses in
3 defending five actions at law, brought against Caribou for
4 damages sustained in an accident, the sum of four hundred
5 fifty-eight dollars and seventy-six cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident took place in nineteen hundred twenty-two. Two people were killed. The bridge in process of reconstruction and under the direction of the state highway commission, who employed its foremen to have general charge of the construction and of protecting the highway by erecting danger signals. The official of the state took steps to obtain evidence at the time against the day when suit might be begun.
