Taxes Erroneously Paid.

Resolved: That there be appropriated for and paid to the
2 town of Hiram the sum of nine hundred eighteen dollars
3 as refund of taxes erroneously paid.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The selectmen of the town of Hiram assessed in 1922 at \$150,000, certain property located in that town as the property of Cumberland County Power and Light Company. On appeal from assessment the supreme judicial court fixed value as \$116,000 in 1925. The amount due Hiram is made up of the following:
