STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the County Attorney for the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred seventeen of

the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended

by striking out the words "seven hundred fifty" after the

word "Hancock" in the eighth line of said section, and in
serting in place thereof the words 'twelve hundred,' so that

said section, so far as it relates to the salary of the county

attorney for the county of Hancock, shall read as follows:

'Hancock, twelve hundred dollars.'
