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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the County Attorney for  
Franklin County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 37; relating to compensation of county attorneys, amended. Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the word "five" after the word "Franklin" in the seventh line of said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'seven hundred and fifty,' so that said section, so far as it relates to the salary of the county attorney for Franklin county, shall read as follows:

'Franklin county, increased. Franklin, seven hundred and fifty dollars.'
