STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of Probate for Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 38; P. L., 1917, cc. 152, 167 and 292; 2 1919, c. 214; 1921, c. 219; 1923, cc. 20 and 45; 1925, cc. 44 3 and 60; relating to compensation of judges of probate, 4 amended. Section thirty-eight of chapter one hundred and 5 seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapters 6 one hundred and fifty-two, one hundred and sixty-seven, 7 and two hundred and ninety-two of the public laws of nine-8 teen hundred and seventeen; by chapter two hundred and 9 fourteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nine-10 teen, by chapter two hundred and nineteen of the public 11 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, and by chapter forty12 five of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-three, 13 and chapter forty-four and sixty of the public laws of nine-14 teen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby further amended 15 by striking out the words "Oxford, twelve hundred and 16 fifty dollars," in the thirteenth line thereof and inserting in 17 place thereof the words, 'Oxford, fifteen hundred dollars,' 18 so that said thirteenth line, as amended, shall read as fol-19 lows:
