STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend an Act to Incorporate the Stockton Springs
Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter one hundred seven of the private
2 and special laws of Maine for the year nineteen hundred
3 and five is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "structures" the words 'and may take and hold, by purchase
5 or otherwise, any land or real estate necessary for preserv-
6 ing the purity of the water and water shed,' so that said
7 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Said company may take and hold any waters
2 as limited in section two and also any lands necessary for
3 reservoirs, and other necessary structures, and may take

4 and hold, by purchase or otherwise, any land or real estate
 5 necessary for preserving the purity of the water in and the
 6 water shed tributary to Boyd Pond, or Half Moon Pond,
 7 in the towns of Searsport and Prospect, and may locate,
 8 lay and maintain aqueducts, pipes, hydrants and other nec-
 9 essary structures or fixtures in, over and through any lands
 10 for its said purposes, and excavate in and through such
 11 lands for such location, construction and maintenance. It
 12 may enter upon such lands to make surveys and location,
 13 and shall file in the registry of deeds for said county of
 14 Waldo, plans of such location and lands, showing the prop-
 15 erty taken, and within thirty days thereafter, publish notice
 16 of such filing in some newspaper in said county, such pub-
 17 lication to be continued three weeks successively. Not more
 18 than one rod in width of land shall be occupied by any one
 19 line of pipe or aqueduct.'
