STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Increase of the Salaries of the County Attorney and the Assistant County Attorney for the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-seven of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the words "two thousand dollars"
4 in the sixth line thereof and inserting in place thereof the
5 words 'twenty-four hundred dollars,' and by striking out the
6 words "twelve hundred dollars" in the twenty-first line
7 thereof and inserting in place thereof the words 'sixteen
8 hundred dollars,' so that said sixth line, as amended, shall
9 read as follows:

'Cumberland, twenty-four hundred dollars.'

10 and said twenty-first line, as amended, in so far as it relates
11 to the annual salary of the assistant county attorney for
12 Cumberland county, shall read as follows:

'sixteen hundred dollars.'
