AN ACT Relating to the Mill Tax Highway Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred sixty-three of the

- 3 of November fourth to eighth, on page thirty, as amended
- 4 by chapter two hundred sixteen of the public laws of nine-
- 5 teen hundred twenty-three, is hereby further amended by
- 6 inserting in the fifth line thereof after the word "hundred"
- 7 the word 'fifty,' so that said section, as amended, shall read
- 8 as follows:
- 'Sec. 1. A tax of one mill on a dollar shall annually be
- 2 assessed on all property of the state according to the value
- 3 thereof, and shall be known as the mill tax highway fund.

4 This fund shall be used for the construction of third class NEW DRAF

5 highways as defined in section five of chapter twenty-five

of the revised statutes, except that not more than one hun-7 dred fifty thousand dollars of the fund shall be annually ased for the construction of highways and bridges and other
