**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN**

AN ACT Relating to the Mill Tax Highway Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred sixty-three of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, special session
3 of November fourth to eighth, on page thirty, as amended
4 by chapter two hundred sixteen of the public laws of nine-
5 teen hundred twenty-three, is hereby further amended by
6 inserting in the fifth line thereof after the word "hundred"
7 the word 'fifty,' so that said section, as amended, shall read
8 as follows:

'Sec. 1. A tax of one mill on a dollar shall annually be
2 assessed on all property of the state according to the value
3 thereof, and shall be known as the mill tax highway fund.

4 This fund shall be used for the construction of third class
5 highways as defined in section five of chapter twenty-five
6 of the revised statutes, except that not more than one hun-
7 dred fifty thousand dollars of the fund shall be annually
8 used for the construction of highways ~~and bridges and other~~
9 purposes contemplated by said chapter twenty-five and in
10 accordance with the terms of any appropriate resolves of the
11 legislature, and further, except that two hundred thousand
12 dollars of said fund shall be transferred and used in the
13 fund for second class or state aid highways.'
