IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit Hunting with Dogs in the Town of Verona in the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person, for a
2 period of five years from the time this act becomes effec3 tive, to hunt with a dog any wild bird or any wild animal
4 within the limits of the town of Verona, in the county of
5 Hancock.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty dollars nor more 3 than one hundred dollars and costs for each offense.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions arising under this act, trial
