IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing by Non-Resident Fishermen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section one of chapter sixty-six of the public laws of nine2 teen hundred and seventeen, as amended by chapter two
3 hundred and one of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
4 twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out all of said
5 section, and by substituting therefor the following section:

'Section I. Persons not bona fide residents of the state, 2 and not actually domiciled therein, except children under 3 fourteen years of age, shall not fish for, take, catch or kill 4 any kind of fish at any time in any of the inland waters of 5 the state, or have the same or any part thereof in posses-6 sion, without first having procured a license therefor as

7 hereinafter provided. Such licenses shall be of such form 8 and style as may be prescribed by commissioner of inland 9 fisheries and game, and shall be issued by town clerks and 10 other agents appointed by said commissioner, under such 11 regulations as may be established by said commissioner upon 12 application in writing on blanks to be furnished by said 13 commissioner and payment of a fee of three dollars and 14 fifteen cents.

Provided, further, that the commissioner of inland fish-2 eries and game may, upon payment of a fee of two dollars 3 and fifteen cents by a non-resident of this state for a special 4 ice fishing license, issue to such applicant a special license 5 authorizing him to fish through the ice for landlocked 6 salmon, trout, togue, black bass and white perch in waters 7 open to ice fishing, in accordance with the general law of 8 the state, such license to expire with the calendar year in 9 which issued."
