# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Regulate the Trapping of Fur-bearing Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty of chapter two hundred and nineteen of the

- 2 public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, as amended
- 3 by chapter two hundred and forty-four of the public laws
- 4 of nineteen hundred and seventeen, and by chapter one hun-
- 5 dred and ninety-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred
- 6 and nineteen, and by chapters fifty-five and seventy of the
- 7 public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby
- 8 further amended by striking out the words "except bobcats,
- 9 loupcervier, or Canada lynx" in the second line of said 10 section.
