RESOLVE, in Favor of a Fish Screen at the Outlet of Messalonskee Lake, in the Town of Oakland, County of Kennebec.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and 2 hereby is, appropriated, to be taken from the appropriation 3 for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries 4 and game, for the purpose of repairing the fish screen in- 5 stalled some years since at the outlet of Messalonskee lake, 6 or Snow pond, the lower lake of the Belgrade Chain of 7 Lakes, in the town of Oakland, county of Kennebec, said 8 money to be expended under the direction of the commis- 9 sioner of inland fisheries and game. Provided, however,

10 that this amount shall not be available until the town of
11 Oakland, or some other town in the county of Kennebec,
12 or an incorporated fish and game club, or association, shall
13 have, by vote of record, voted to assume all care for the
14 keeping of same free from debris, so that the natural flow
15 of water at the outlet of said lake will not be interfered with.
16 If this appropriation is not expended during the year 1927
17 it shall be available during the year 1928.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Necessary repairs must be made to the fish screen installed some years since at the foot of Messalonskee lake.

This resolve is introduced for the purpose of providing the necessary funds to make such repairs.
