STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Purchase of
Additional Real Estate for the State School for Girls.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of eight hundred dollars for the purchase of additional
3 real estate situate in Hallowell, Kennebec county, Maine,
4 needed by the State School for Girls for pasturage.

The same to be expended and said purchase made by the
2 trustees of said institution subject to the approval of the
3 governor and council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The land herein referred to is a ten acre lot adjoining the school land on the west, which the trustees have been hiring for the past few years and is the only land available for pasture use of said school.
