STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of State School for Girls.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the state school for girls for the fiscal year, July first, nine-3 teen hundred twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen hun-4 dred twenty-eight, inclusive the sum of eighty thousand, five 5 hundred forty dollars and ninety-six cents for the purposes 6 hereinafter specified, namely: Personal services for salaries and wages of officers

and employees, \$25,000.00 Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair, 42,000.00

Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and

labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds,

buildings, and attached fixtures,13,000.00Interest on trust funds,540.96

And be it further resolved that there be and hereby is ap-2 propriated for the state school for girls for the fiscal year 3 July first, nineteen hundred twenty-eight to June thirtieth, 4 nineteen hundred twenty-nine, inclusive, the further sum 5 of eighty thousand, five hundred forty dollars and ninety-6 six cents for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers and employees, \$25,000.00

Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all
articles of personal clothing and materials for
their fabrication and repair,42,000.00Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and

labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds,

buildings, and attached fixtures, 13,000.00

Interest on trust funds,

540.96

Provided, that the governor and council, may, by order, 2 upon recommendation of the trustees of said institution, 3 authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the 4 above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropria-5 tions for the same institution.
