RESOLVE, in Favor of the State School for Boys.

---

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for  
2 the state school for boys for the fiscal year July first, nine-  
3 teen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nineteen  
4 hundred and twenty-eight, inclusive, the sum of sixty-eight  
5 thousand and forty-two dollars for the purposes hereinafter  
6 specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers

and employes,

\$19,500.00

Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all

articles of personal clothing and materials for

their fabrication and repair,

36,000.00

Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures,	11,000.00
Repairs to Farrington Cottage,	1,500.00
Interest on trust funds,	42.00

And be it further resolved: that there be and hereby is, 2 appropriated for the state school for boys for the fiscal year 3 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to June thir- 4 tieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, inclusive, the fur- 5 ther sum of sixty-eight thousand and forty-two dollars 6 for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

Personal services for salaries and wages of officers and employes,	\$19,500.00
Maintenance for food supplies, wearing apparel, all articles of personal clothing and materials for their fabrication and repair,	36,000.00
Repairs and equipment, all materials, supplies and labor required for repairs and upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures,	11,000.00
Repairs to Farrington Cottage,	1,500.00
Interest on trust funds,	42.00

Provided, that the governor and council may, by order, 2 upon recommendation of the trustees of said institution, 3 authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the 4 above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropria- 5 tions for the same institution.
