RESOLVE, in Favor of the State School for Girls at
Hallowell.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to the State School for Girls, for reconstructing
3 and furnishing a wing of Erskine Cottage for an infirmary,
4 the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars and to aid in the
5 construction of a vegetable cellar in connection with said
6 institution, the sum of five hundred dollars.
