IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Compilation and
Publication of Data Concerning the Resources of the State.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of fifty thousand dollars for the fiscal year from July
3 one, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, to June thirty, nine-
4 teen hundred twenty-eight, and the sum of fifty thousand
5 dollars for the fiscal year from July one, nineteen hundred
6 twenty-eight, to June thirty, nineteen hundred twenty-nine,
7 for the purpose of compiling and publishing data regarding
8 the agricultural, industrial and recreational resources of the

9 state of Maine for general distribution to all persons inter-
10 ested in the state of Maine; said sums to be expended under
11 the direction of the governor and council.
