# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize the Portland Railroad Company to Operate Motor Busses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: The Portland Railroad Company is hereby authorized and
2 empowered to use and operate motor busses and other
3 vehicles propelled by gasoline or electric or other power,
4 subject to the approval of the Public Utilities Commission,
5 in cities and towns in which said company is now authorized
6 to operate its railroad, upon and over locations granted by
7 said cities and towns with the consent of the municipal offi8 cers thereof and subject to such conditions and regulations
9 as they may impose.
