## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Appropriation of Motor Vehicle Registration and Operators' License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-two of chapter two hundred and eleven of

- 2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one is here-
- 3 by amended, so that, as amended, it shall read as follows:

'Sect. 92. All fees and moneys received by the secretary

- 2 of state under the preceding sections shall be turned over
- 3 to the treasurer of state as provided in section twenty-six
- 4 of this act, and shall be appropriated and used for the repair
- 5 and maintenance of state highways and state aid highways,
- 6 and to meet all provisions of the bond issues for highway
- 7 construction as provided by statute. The expense of ad-

8 ministering the motor vehicle department and the licensing 9 of operators and registration of vehicles incurred by the 10 secretary of state shall be paid out of a specific appropria11 tion for that purpose.'
