STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Appropriation of Automobile Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter two hundred and fifty-one of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, special ses-
3 sion, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Sect. 4. All fees received by the treasurer of state from
2 the licensing of operators and the registration of vehicles, and
3 all fines and forfeitures collected under the provisions of
4 section ninety-three of chapter two hundred and eleven of
5 the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, as
6 amended by chapter ninety-eight of the public laws of nine-
7 teen hundred and twenty-five, and payable to the state high-
8 way commission, as provided by said chapter ninety-eight,

9 shall be appropriated and used in the following order,
10 namely :

‘1. To pay interest due on all bonds issued by the state
2 for the construction of state highways, intrastate, interstate
3 and international bridges.

‘2. To create such funds as shall be necessary to redeem
2 and retire bonds issued for the construction of state high-
3 ways, intrastate, interstate and international bridges, as they
4 shall mature.

‘3. To provide funds for the maintenance of state and
2 state aid highways as required by statute; and any balance
3 left unexpended in any year shall be carried over to the
4 same account for the following year.’
