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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to Amend Chapter Eleven of the Private and Special  
Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-five, Incorporating  
the Bay Point Village Corporation.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter eleven of the private and special  
2 laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five is hereby amended  
3 by striking out all of said section and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following section, said section as amended shall  
5 read as follows:

‘Section 1. The territory embraced within the following  
2 limits, to wit: All that portion of Bay Point, so-called, in  
3 the town of Georgetown, which is bounded and described  
4 as follows, viz: Beginning at the southwest corner bound

5 of the land of Kenneth Dunlop, thence running southerly  
6 across the highway to the northwest corner bound of land  
7 of Fred L. Andrews; thence southerly by land of said An-  
8 drews to low water mark on the shore of Eels Eddy Bay;  
9 thence following the shore southerly, westerly and north-  
10 erly by low water mark of Eels Eddy Bay, Atlantic Ocean  
11 and Long Island Narrows to the southwest corner of land  
12 of the heirs of John Warren; thence easterly by the south-  
13 erly line of the land of the said John Warren heirs to the  
14 highway; thence easterly along the highway by land of  
15 John Warren heirs and land of Elijah Spinney heirs to the  
16 point of beginning; together with the inhabitants thereon,  
17 and certain owners of real estate thereon, as hereinafter  
18 specified, is hereby created a body politic and corporate, by  
19 the name of the Bay Point Village Corporation.'
