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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT to Repeal Acts Incorporating the Kendalls Mills  
Village Corporation and the Fairfield Village Corporation.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Acts of incorporation repealed; proviso. All  
2 acts heretofore enacted for the incorporation of the Ken-  
3 dalls Mills Village Corporation and the Fairfield Village  
4 Corporation within the present town of Fairfield in the  
5 county of Somerset are hereby repealed; provided that the  
6 corporate existence, powers, duties and liabilities of said  
7 Kendalls Mills Village Corporation and Fairfield Village  
8 Corporation shall survive for the purpose of prosecuting  
9 and defending all actions and causes of action to which

10 said Kendalls Mills Village Corporation and Fairfield Vil-  
11 lage Corporation are parties, and collecting payment of all  
12 claims and demands now existing in favor of or against  
13 said Kendalls Mills Village Corporation and Fairfield Vil-  
14 lage Corporation and all needful processes growing out of  
15 the same.

Sect. 2. Town of Fairfield authorized to assume liabilities  
2 of village corporation. The town of Fairfield may, at a  
3 meeting legally called by a warrant and containing an article  
4 for that purpose, by vote, assume all the outstanding lia-  
5 bilities of said Kendalls Mills Village Corporation and Fair-  
6 field Village Corporation on the day when this act takes  
7 effect, and in case said town so votes, they shall have au-  
8 thority to raise money by loan upon town orders, notes or  
9 bonds which shall be valid claims upon said town, with  
10 which to discharge such liabilities and thereupon all the  
11 property and assets of said Kendalls Mills Village Corpo-  
12 ration and Fairfield Village Corporation shall become the  
13 property of and vested in said town.

Sect. 3. Act not effective until accepted by town. This  
2 act shall take effect when accepted by a majority of the  
3 legal voters of Fairfield present and voting at any annual  
4 meeting, or special meeting, of said town, the warrant con-  
5 taining an article for that purpose.
