AN ACT to Amend Section One, Chapter Eighty-four of the Revised Statutes in Relation to the Appointment of Clerks of the Judicial Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter eighty-four of the revised statutes 2 is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

'Section 1. Clerks of the judicial courts shall hereafter 2 be appointed by the justices of the supreme judicial court, 3 or a majority of them and hold office for the term of four 4 years, unless removed by said justices for cause; but all 5 such clerks now in office shall continue to hold their office 6 until the expiration of the term for which they were ap-

7 pointed or elected, or until a vacancy occurs from some
8 other cause. All such clerks shall be residents of the county
9 for which they are appointed.'
