## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Purposes for which Cities and Towns

May Raise Money.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Cities and towns may raise money for the maintenance or

- 2 employment of a band of music for municipal purposes and
- 3 public celebrations. The provisions of this act shall not
- 4 be in force in any city or town unless approved by a major-
- 5 ity vote of the qualified voters of such city or town at an 6 annual election.
