STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Brownville and Williamsburg Water
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section twelve of chapter one hundred ninety-
2 nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred
3 three, is hereby amended by striking out in the third line
4 thereof the words "not exceeding twenty-five thousand dol-
5 lars," so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 12. The said corporation, for all its said purposes,
2 may hold real and personal estate necessary and convenient
3 therefor.'

Sect. 2. The acts of the company in its acquisition and
2 holding of property exceeding the amount of twenty-five
3 thousand dollars are hereby ratified, confirmed and made
4 valid.
