STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Ratify and Make Valid Quitclaim Deed Given by Highway Commission for Property Located Near State Ferry in Woolwich.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the quitclaim deed given by the state

- 2 highway commission for the state of Maine to Laura E.
- 3 Farnham of Woolwich in the county of Sagadahoc quit-

- 5 and to certain land described in said deed, said deed being

- 3 of Maine quitclaiming any interest that the said Laura E.
